Impact on Student IQ

What is the impact of NILD Educational Therapy® on student intelligence?

Historically, society believed that intelligence is a fixed trait that remained stable over the life span. NILD believes that intelligence resembles a state that can be modified. Recent research supports evidence for neuroplasticity, indicating that students can increase their capacity to learn. The following graph demonstrates that the majority of participants in NILD Educational Therapy® experienced a positive growth in overall intelligence.

IQ Classification Changes

How is growth in student intelligence reflected in IQ classifications among participants in NILD Educational Therapy®?

Students in the low-average or below categories decreased in number, whereas students in the Average to Superior categories increased in number over time in NILD Educational Therapy®. Post-test scores indicated that 73% of participating students had an Average to Superior intelligence classification, compared to 58% at the pre-test.





Impact on IQ by Age

Is intellectual growth demonstrated across elementary, middle, and high school-aged students?

It is important to note that the typical trajectory for students with diagnosed learning disorders is no gain or regression over time in both intelligence and achievement. However, this graph highlights positive intellectual growth across all age ranges, with elementary students showing the largest percent of change gains.


As measured by the Wechsler Intelligence Scale for Children IV. NILD Educational Therapy students of all ages showed positive gain in intellect.






Impact on Test Scores

Within the 8-10 age group that shows the greatest IQ change, what academic changes are also evident?

All age groups demonstrated academic achievement gains in all domains. However, similar to the student intellect improvement pattern, the 8–10 age group also demonstrated the most academic growth, reaching the highest level of statistical significance regarding growth due to treatment effect.






Effectiveness by Demographics
